Artwork creation specifics

- Each artist can submit an unlimited number of artworks
- The artwork can be either recent or older, as long as it was made by the participant
- The artwork can be of any art format (visual, audio, etc.) and it must be shareable online
- The artwork may be inspired by the virtual residence debates about the future of Europe, or be an interpretation of the European values discussed during the debates (democracy, equality, cohesion, climate biodiversity, digital).
- Your artwork does not have to specifically refer to any of the topics! Just show us what you are feeling right now! No limitation, freedom of creation!

Artwork format specifics

- For audio-visuals (song, short movie, performance, etc.): maximum length of 5 minutes.
- Writing: max 1,500 words.
- Pictures: 1 to 5 pictures.

Voting and awarding specifics

- Awards will be given for each of the 6 topics (1st, 2nd, 3rd place), so a total of 18 artworks will be awarded.
- You will vote online between the 4th and the 5th of June, 12PM C.E.T.
- The online form will have 6 sections, representing the 6 topics: you will vote by choosing 1 artwork for each category (up to you to decide which artwork was more valuable for each category).

Artwork Submission specifics

- We will provide you with a link on the 31st of May, with a folder specific to you, where you can upload your artwork (you have time to do so until the 2nd of June).
- In your folder you will find a copyright notice and a template document, where you can further explain your art process.
- Each artwork must be named with these elements: the author's name + the title of the work. **E.g. NameSurname_ArtworkTitle**
